J T Bowne's Directory of Glen Cove (1867)

In 1867, as Glen Cove preapred to celebrate the 200th anniversary of its founding, Jacob T. Bowne compiled a manuscript directory of tradesman and businessmen in Glen Cove, New York. The manuscript was preserved as part of the Bowne-Krasnoff collection, a collection of manuscript and printed materials documenting Glen Cove's bicentennial celebration in 1868, which was purchased by industrialist Abe Krassnoff and donated to the Glen Cove Public Library.

The son of local merchant R M Bowne, Jacob T Bowne was one of Glen Cove's earliest antiquarians. It was he who pushed for Glen Cove to throw a gala party to celebrate the two hundreth anniversary of the community's founding. In addition to his histrorical and genealogical research, Bowne was also one of the founders of the YMCA movement in Glen Cove. This work would eventually take him away from Glen Cove as he assumed a leadership position in the YMCA organizations in Hudson and then Newburgh, NY, and eventually the International Committee of the YMCA. Bowne would be instrumental in creating the YMCA's first historical archives, which still exist today.

Bowne's Directory is far from complete. A cursory examination of extant Glen Cove newspapers from 1867 quickly reveals a number of tradesmen and business which Bowne does not incorporate into his Directory. He also does not include most of the hotels, boarding houses, or food service establishments in Glen Cove. However, his directory is by far more complete that Curtin's 1868 directory of Glen Cove, and interested readers are invited to compare the two.

Readers should note that "Glen Street" encompassed modern-day School Street as well; "Main Street" is modern-day Landing Road, and Bowne's use of the term "Landing" appears to incorporate a wider area than merely Landing Road. All of Glen Cove south of the mill ponds (today's Glen Cove Arterial Highway) was, at that time, referred to as "South Glen Cove", and was just beginning to be developed; modern-day Glen Cove Avenue was known as "South Street". "Bay Street" is modern-day Garvies Point Road, and "Front Street" is modern-day Shore Road. Today's Pulaski Street, off of Glen Street, was originally the mill dam separating the upper and lower mill ponds, and was known as "Mill Street". - DER
